

What types of projects are authorised?

Let's look at it under another angle. All projects are eligible except:

- Trading CO2 emission rights, gas or electricity
- Trading of oil products
- Real estate
- Sensitive resources (for instance coltan, cobalt, uranium, palm oil, ...)
- Trading (i.e. organized market)
- Military material (weapons, armed vehicles, ammunition, night goggles, ...)
- Controversial products/services (fur, porn industry, promoting and use of softdrugs)
- Trading mobile phones
- Trading used vehicles
- Trading electronic components
- Trading diamonds and gem stones
- Antiques and art trading
- Tobacco and alcohol (whole sale)
- Trading horses (buying, selling, breeding, insemination,...)
- Financial institutions that do not fall under art. 2 of the 2005/60/EG Directive
- Facilitating money transfers over the internet for third parties
- Scrap dealers
- Buyers of furniture
- House to house traders and market traders
- Exploit gambling games
- Exploitation of commercial billboards
- Activities in the sex industry, night clubs, escort agencies
- Industrial cleaning
- Religious or political purpose which might be societal questionable
- Paranormal activities
- Embassy or consulate in Belgium
- Companies involved in service checks
- Terrorism and financing of terrorism
- Organized crime
- Trafficking illegal workforces
- Human trafficking
- Organ or tissue trafficking
